For 2010-2011, Nah Tah Wahsh once again has made Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) in the areas that are measured, English language arts and mathematics. Nah Tah Wahsh is a Schoolwide Title 1 school and has not been identified for improvement. While we are pleased to have reached this important goal, we are continuously working to improve. We appreciate the continued support of parents, staff and our community in this effort.

State law requires that we also report the following additional information.


1. Nah Tah Wahsh is a Public School Academy. Enrollment is open, with transportation provided within a 25-mile radius. All Nah Tah Wahsh teachers and paraprofessionals are Highly Qualified.
2. The School Improvement Plan is updated annually and posted on the website. It is also available in the school principal's office. Annual goals are set based on data analysis of the previous year, with an action plan describing how the goals will be achieved and how the plan will be evaluated.
3. The Core Curriculum is continually being updated, with Pacing Guides showing what is taught in each grade level to meet the state standards. It is posted on the website as it is updated, with hard copies available in the school principal's office also. Professional development with staff includes

incorporating the newly adopted Common Core Standards into our curriculum.

4. Nah Tah Wahsh is a K-12 school. The parent participation continues to be the highest in the elementary grades. Parent participation average for all grades was 79% in 2009-10, and 56% in 2010-2011. Participation rates are determined by parent attendance at conferences and ranged from 86% in kindergarten to less than 50% in high school. Parental involvement is an area that we continually try to improve on, including holding student-led conferences three times a year.
5. Although dual enrollment is available, only one student took advantage of this opportunity in 2009-10 and there were no high school students with dual enrollment at Bay College and at Nah Tah Wahsh during the 2010-2011 school year.
6. Nah Tah Wahsh PSA does not offer COLLEGE EQUIVALENT (AP) COURSES at this time.

The administration and school board congratulate the staff and students on continuing to achieve AYP. This would not be possible without the ongoing support of the parents and community as well. Thank you for your commitment to make Nah Tah Wahsh the very best educational system possible.
